KNDC is a faith-rooted nonprofit serving Southwest Yonkers from a single corner of Palisade Avenue. We operate a client-choice emergency food pantry every Saturday, supplemented by hot meals on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays, Green Thumb fresh-produce bags, and home delivery for homebound seniors. Alongside the pantry, KNDC runs small-business coaching, financial-literacy workshops, and workforce-readiness support — meeting the most urgent material needs while building long-horizon ladders out of poverty.
